

HISPANIC-LATIN AMERICAN PROGRAM

Policy & Procedure 0039 F

Sec. 1. The Men's, Women's, and Mixed Hispanic-Latin American World Tournament will feature the following divisions: Hispanic Men's Competitive, Hispanic Men's Recreational, Hispanic Women's Competitive, Hispanic Women's Recreational and Hispanic Mixed Competitive, and Hispanic Mixed Recreational.

Sec. 2. Players with PRV's of C or higher are required to participate in the Hispanic-Latin American Competitive Division.

Sec. 3. A Hispanic-Latin American team playing in the Men's, Women's, and Mixed Hispanic Competitive Division may have two players on its roster whose name appears on the Major Players List, Major Watch List, and/or AA PRV.

Sec. 4. A Hispanic-Latin American team playing in the Men's, Women's, and Mixed Hispanic Recreational Division may have only players who compete in the Class "D" or lower classification and the player must have a "D Elite" PRV (Player Rating Value) or below.

Sec. 5. Teams participating in the Men's and Women's Hispanic-Latin American Program will be allowed to have 4 players who are not of Hispanic-Latin American origin on their roster.

Sec. 6. Teams participating in the Mixed Hispanic-Latin American Program may only be allowed to play 4 non-Hispanic American origin on their roster. They must compete with a balanced number of male-to-female players (5/5 or 6/6)

Hispanic Men's Competitive	8 – *DBO Excessive
Hispanic Men's Recreational	2 – *IEO Excessive
Hispanic Women's Competitive	Unlimited
Hispanic Women's Recreational	2 – *IEO Excessive
Hispanic Mixed Competitive	5 Per Gender – *DBO Excessive
Hispanic Mixed Recreational	2 Per Gender – *IEO Excessive

*DBO – Dead Ball Out

*IEO – Inning Ending Out

Sec. 7. Players are eligible to participate in the Hispanic-Latin American Program by birth and/or adoption.

Sec. 8. All playing rules not specifically covered in this rule, shall be governed by the other rules, as outlined in Rules 1 through 10 of the USSSA Rule Book.
